

How to Add the Arabic Language to Vista and Windows 7

The Arabic language pack allows users to read and write Arabic from the convenience of their home computer.

Instructions

○ 1

Click the Windows Vista/Windows 7 icon at the left end of the desktop toolbar.

○ 2

Select "Settings."

○ 3

Click "Clock, Language and Region."

○ 4

Select "Change keyboards or other input methods."

○ 5

Click "Change keyboards."

○ 6

Click "Add" and select the Arabic language you want to install from the drop-down menu.

○ 7

Click "OK," then "Apply" to finalize your selection. Click "OK" again to exit the application.

Arabic Language setup in Vista and Windows 7 via Windows Update

Select Start button in the lower left corner of the desktop.

Click 'All programs' and choose "Windows Update" program.

Run the Windows Update.

Select Optional tab and click on "Arabic Language Pack".

Click OK button and then click install updates button.
