Adding the Language to Windows

Step 1. Install Supplemental Language Support

The Arabic language requires that you install Supplemental Language Support before you can set it up in Windows.

- 1. Select the Start button in the lower left corner of the Desktop.
- 2. Select the Control Panel (or, if you are using the Windows Classic Setting, select Settings > Control Panel).
- 3. In the Control Panel, double-click the Regional and Language Options item.
- 4. In the Regional and Languages dialog box, click on the Languages tab. In the Supplemental language support section, click on the Install files for complex script and right-to-left languages (including Thai) option (see Figure below).
- 5. Click on the Apply button in the lower right corner of the dialog box and then click on the OK button. You may be prompted to insert your Windows install CD into the CD drive.
